

Conflict minerals policy

- Pragmatic Semiconductor Ltd supports industry-wide efforts to identify, reduce and hopefully eliminate the use of conflict minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries to the extent believed to be financing or benefiting groups committing human rights violations. We are committed to complying with any applicable requirements under the Conflict Minerals Rule and has implemented a due-diligence process to meet its obligations under the legislation.
- We do not directly source or process conflict minerals and has endeavoured to remove any Conflict Minerals from the manufacturing process. As part of our reasonable due diligence, we have contacted our P providers within our supply chain to verify their continued compliance with the regulations.
- Our Suppliers are expected to establish their own conflict minerals policies, due diligence frameworks and management systems that are designed to prevent conflict minerals originating from the DRC or an adjoining country, to the extent that they benefit groups committing human rights violations, from being included in the products sold to us. In the event we determine that a supplier has failed to develop and implement reasonable steps to comply with this Policy, PragmatlC reserves the right to take appropriate actions, which may include discontinuing the business relationship with the supplier.

Based on the information received thus far we declare that our products do not contain Conflict Minerals. We also declare that any materials provided via our supply chain with the potential to contain Conflict Minerals are sourced from conflict-free areas.
